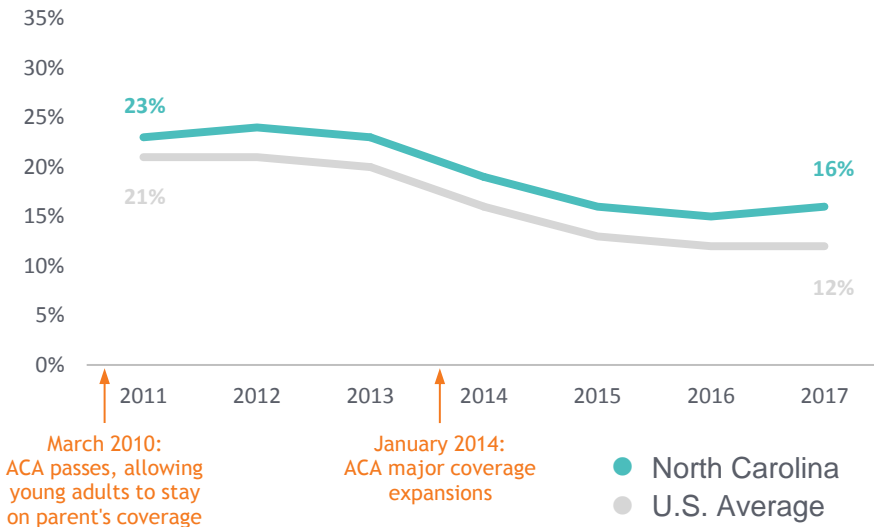

## Changes in Health Care Coverage & Access

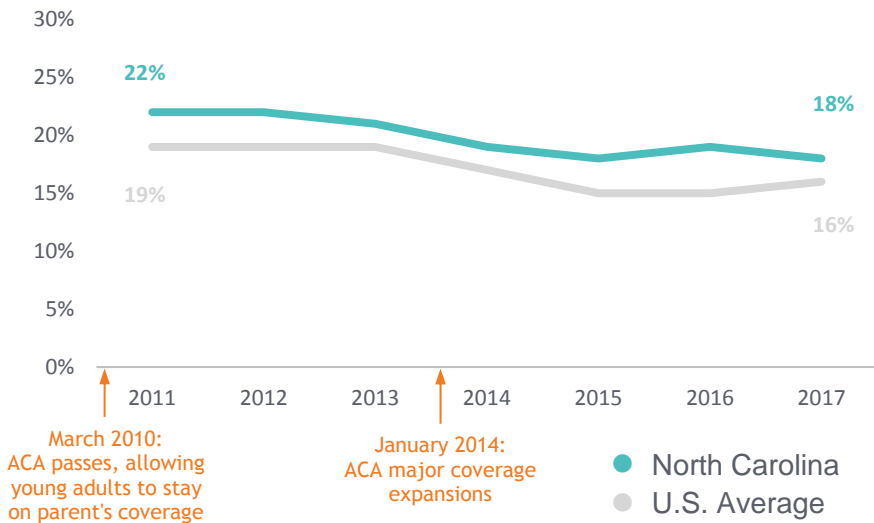
Following the Affordable Care Act's coverage expansions, more people in North Carolina have health insurance and are better able to get, and afford, the health care they need.
